

SPAIN

Picking of the 2019/20 cotton crop is almost completed. The harvest has been assisted by favourable weather conditions and the lint outturn is thus expected to be classed predominantly as Middling to Strict Middling. Ginning is estimated to be about 60 percent complete and should be finished by mid-November.

Roughly 80 percent of the crop is thought to have been committed by ginners to the trade, and shipments are in full swing. The principal destinations mentioned have been Pakistan, Vietnam and Bangladesh.
